Round 1: Elimination Round

Format:

- Participants: 100
- Objective: Reduce the number of participants to 40.

Structure:

1. Questions: Each participant will answer 15 multiple-choice questions (MCQs).

2. Time Limit: Each question must be answered within 30

seconds. 3. Scoring:

- a. 1 point for each correct answer.
- b. Negative marking for each incorrect answer.

4. Cut-off: The top 40 participants with the highest scores will proceed to the next round.

Rules:

- Participants must stay silent during the questioning.
- Participants can use a pen and paper for calculations.

Round 2: Fastest Finger First

Format:

- Participants: 40
- Objective: Identify 20 participants for the final round.

Structure:

1. Questions: Each participant will answer a single question. 2.

Time Limit: Each question must be answered within 10 seconds.

3. Scoring: The first 20 participants to answer correctly will move on to the final round.

Rules:

Participants must buzz in to answer.
If a participant answers incorrectly, they will be disqualified from this round.

Round 3: Final Round

Format:

- Participants: 20
- Objective: Answer 15 questions with increasing

difficulty. Structure:

- **1. Questions: 15 multiple-choice questions.**
- 2. Difficulty Levels: Questions will range from easy to very

difficult. 3. Time Limit:

- a. Questions 1-5: 30 seconds each.
- b. Questions 6-10: 45 seconds each.
- c. Questions 11-15: 1 minute each.
- 4. Lifelines: Each participant can use up to 2 lifelines:
- a. 50:50
- b. Flip of question

Scoring:

Correct answers increase in prize money corresponding to difficulty levels.

 Incorrect answers may result in elimination depending on the question's significance.

Rules:

- Participants must answer within the given time.
- Lifelines can be used only once per question.

General Guidelines
