Rules for the Competition :

- Use of Stencil is Strictly Prohibited
- You can use Colour Bottles to fill Colours.
- One team comprises maximum 3 members only.
- Teams will be responsible for arrangement of the material required to prepare rangoli.
- Only rangoli colours can be used for making rangoli.
- The participants will not be allowed to refer to any printed material etc. for preparing Rangoli.
- Any act of indiscipline by participants calls for cancellation of registration.

- Judges decision will be final and binding.

- Relevance/Depth of theme
- Creativity
- Colour combination Message through Rangoli {Details and Clarity in Rangoli Art}.
- Overall Appearance and appeal
